- Position themselves and their teams for success in the future.

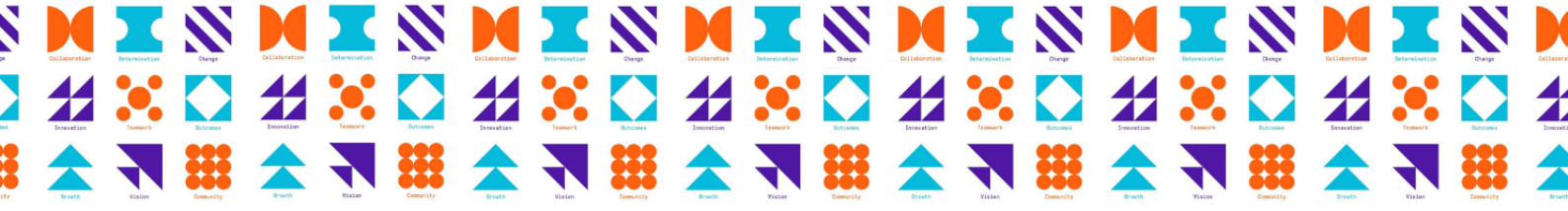

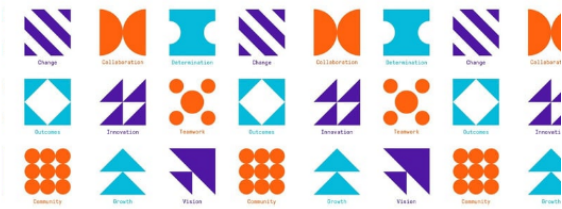
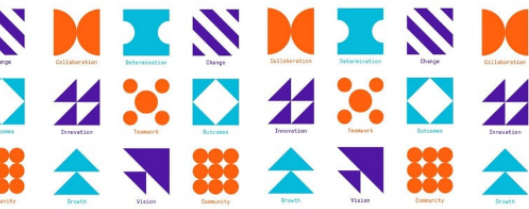
What we want to achieve in this rapidly changing and complex world cannot be done alone. More than ever, leadership is less about the power we have over people and more about the power we can create together.
